
B.S. in Journalism Suggested 4-Year Academic Flowchart

- **One course from each of the following GE areas must be completed: A1, A2, A3, B1, B2, B3, (B4 [lab] must be completed with either B2 or B3),
- B1-B5 elective, C1, C2, C3, C4, D1, D2, D3, D5 and F. C4, D5 and F should be taken only after Junior standing is reached (90 units).

One (1) course must be completed from B1, in addition to STAT 130, 217, 218 or 251.
