**One course from each of the following GE areas must be completed: A1, A2, A3, B1, B2, Upper-Division B, C1, C2, Lower-Division C Elective, Upper-Division C, D1, D2, Upper-Division D, and GE Elective. Upper-Division B, Upper-Division C, and Upper-Division D should be taken only after Junior standing is reached (90 units).

USCP requirement can be satisfied by some (but not all) courses within GE categories: Upper-Division B, C1, Upper-Division C, D1, Upper-Division D, or E.

¹ If GE courses are used to satisfy Support or Concentration requirements, additional free elective units may be required to satisfy 180 units for degree.

² See catalog for options. Courses taken in the Support Elective area cannot double count in Concentration.

³ Recommend RPTA 463 is taken 2 quarters prior to RPTA 465.
