

## MOST GENERAL EDUCATION COURSES CAN BE TAKEN IN ANY ORDER AS LONG AS PREREQUISITES ARE MET

Students are encouraged to enroll in an average of 16 units per quarter.

\* Refer to current catalog for prerequisites.

\*\*One course from each of the following GE areas must be completed: A1, A2, A3, B1, B2, Upper-Division B, C1, C2, Lower-Division C Elective, Upper-Division C, D1, Upper-Division D, F, and GE Elective. Upper-Division B, Upper-Division C, and Upper-Division D should be taken only after Junior standing is reached (90 units).

Refer to online catalog for GE course selection, United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) and Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR).

USCP requirement can be satisfied by some (but not all) courses within GE categories: Upper-Division B, C1, Upper-Division C, D1, Upper-Division D, or E.

<sup>1</sup> If GE courses are used to satisfy Support or Concentration requirements, additional free elective units may be required to satisfy 180 units for degree.

<sup>2</sup> Choose either BUS or AGB route. BUS 212 or 214 is a prerequiaite for BUS 215, and AGB 214 is a prerequisite for AGB 323.

<sup>3</sup> Recommend RPTA 463 is taken 2 guarters prior to RPTA 465.

<sup>4</sup> RPTA 465 can be taken any quarter senior year after all degree required coursework is completed.

<sup>5</sup> A minimum of 24 units of coursework, of which a minimum of 12 units must be RPTA prefix, and a minimum of 4 units must be Upper Division. Courses are selected by the student in consultation with the student's academic advisor, and the ICS must be approved by the academic advisor.
