<sup>2</sup> Minimum 20 units free electives. If upper-division GE courses are used to satisfy Major requirements, additional upper-division coursework may be required to satisfy the University's 60-units upper-division requirement.

<sup>3</sup> Students may not declare a Spanish minor. Courses in a minor may not be used to satisfy Major requirements or Approved Electives in BA Spanish (no double counting of coursework).
